FOOD ASSISTANCE GOVT. PROGRAMS

SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program)

Qualifying families receive an EBT card that they can use to purchase food at supermarkets AND two of the Loudoun Farmers Markets (Leesburg & Cascades).

- Matching funds at both farmers markets (\$20 worth of food for \$10)
