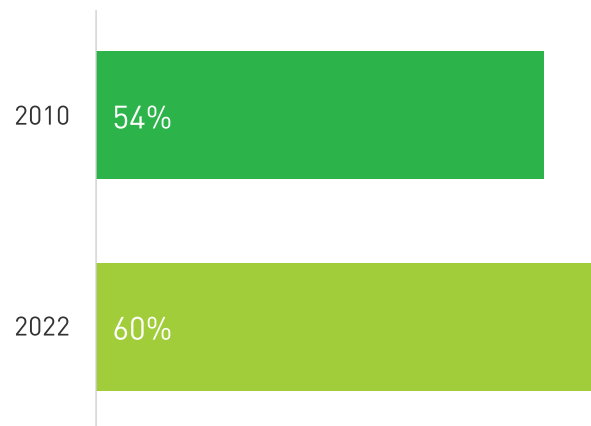

BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

Georgia WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by **11 percent** between 2010 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in Georgia in 2022, **19 percent** continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
