

### **BREASTFEEDING IN WIC**

Georgia WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by 11 percent between 2010 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in Georgia in 2022, 19 percent continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
