BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

Indiana WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by 19 percent between 2010 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in Indiana in 2022, **26 percent** continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
