BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

Minnesota WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by 6 percent between 2010 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in Minnesota in 2022, 35 percent continued breastfeeding at 6 months.



Online Shopping: The Midwest States WIC Online Ordering Pilot (MSWOOP) implemented an online shopping and payment solution with regional grocery vendor Hy-Vee and WIC EBT (eWIC) processor FIS/CDP in 2024. The project recently expanded to stores in Minnesota.
