BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

Mississippi WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by **23 percent** between 2010 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in Mississippi in 2022, 12 percent continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
