### **BREASTFEEDING IN WIC**

Nevada WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by **27** percent between 1998 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in Nevada in 2022, **20 percent** continued breastfeeding at 6 months.



**Online Shopping:** Nevada WIC is working to create an online shopping solution for vendors that do not have online shopping technology available for their stores. They are using the WICShopper app to improve the WIC shopping experience with WIC vendors that are interested in app-to-app integration. WIC participants will order WIC-approved foods through the app and the app will pass the orders on to participating vendors, which are currently Save Mart and commissaries operated by the Defense Commissary Agency, for fulfillment.
