

## MORTALITY AND BIRTH OUTCOMES

Maternal mortality per 100,000 births, 2018-2022... 17.5

Infant mortality per 1,000 live births, 2022..... 5.7

Preterm birth rate, 2022..... 10% Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in Pennsylvania in 2022, 14 percent continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
