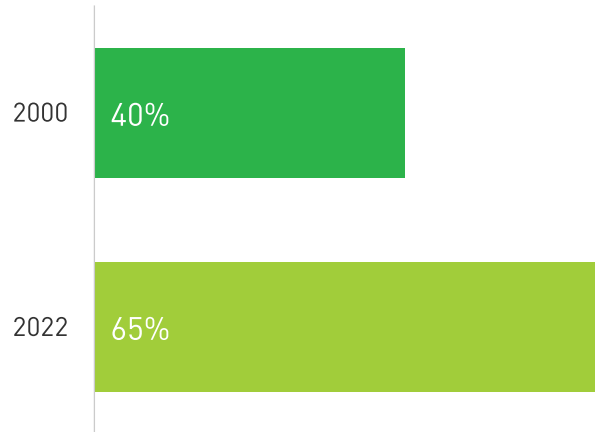

## BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

Chickasaw Nation WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by **62 percent** between 2000 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in Chickasaw Nation in 2022, **19 percent** continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
