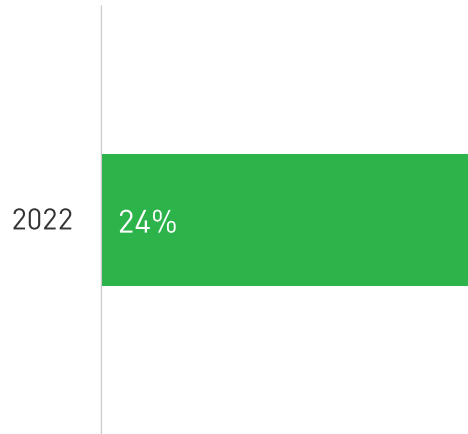

## BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

In 2022, **24 percent** of 6- to 13-month-old infants and children in FSIP (NM) initiated breastfeeding.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in Five Sandoval Pueblos in 2022, **20 percent** continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
