

BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

The Navajo Nation WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by 9 percent between 1998 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in the Navajo Nation in 2022, 34 percent continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
