

### **BREASTFEEDING IN WIC**

The Muscogee Creek Nation WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by 33 percent between 2000 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in the Muscogee Creek Nation in 2022, 15 percent continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
