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

BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

The Inter-Tribal Council of Oklahoma WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by **130 percent** between 2000 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in the Inter-Tribal Council of Oklahoma in 2022, **23 percent** continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
