

BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

The Otoe-Missouria Tribe WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by 11 percent between 1998 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in the Otoe-Missouria Tribe in 2022, 7 percent continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
