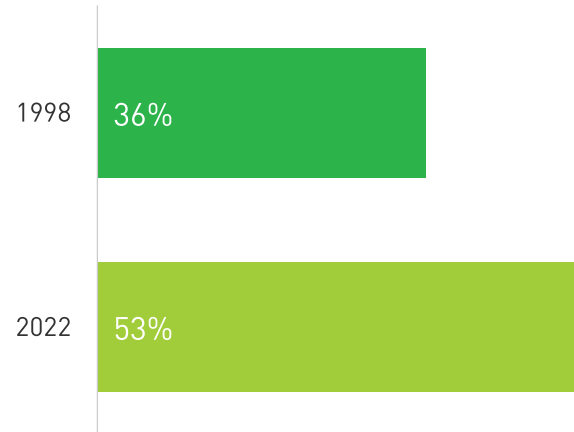

BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

Osage Tribal Council WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by **47 percent** between 1998 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in Osage Tribal Council in 2022, **23 percent** continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
