

BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

The Wichita, Caddo, and Delaware Tribes WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by **92 percent** between 2000 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in the Wichita, Caddo, and Delaware Tribes in 2022, **16 percent** continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
