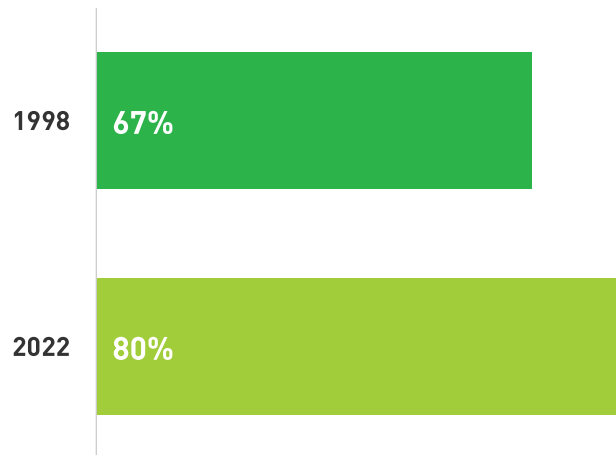

BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

Alaska WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by **20 percent** between 1998 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in Alaska in 2022, **39 percent** continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
