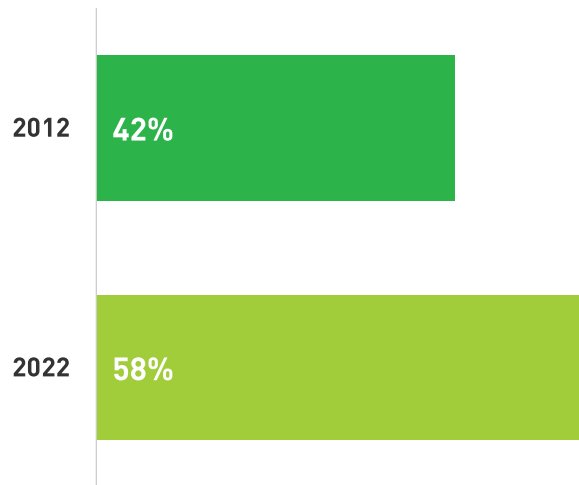

## BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

Delaware WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by **37 percent** between 2012 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in Delaware in 2022, **24 percent** continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
