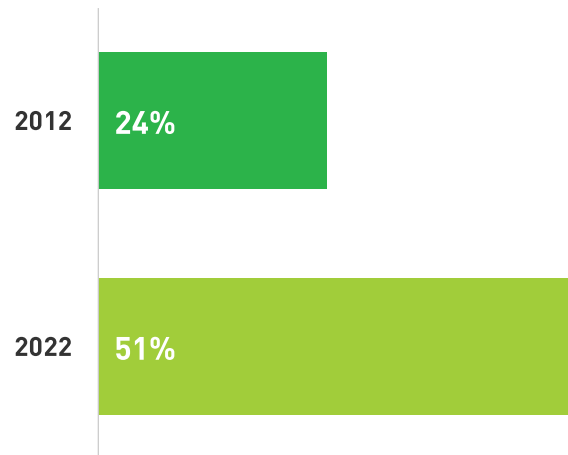

BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

Kentucky WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by **109 percent** between 2012 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in Kentucky in 2022, **13 percent** continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
