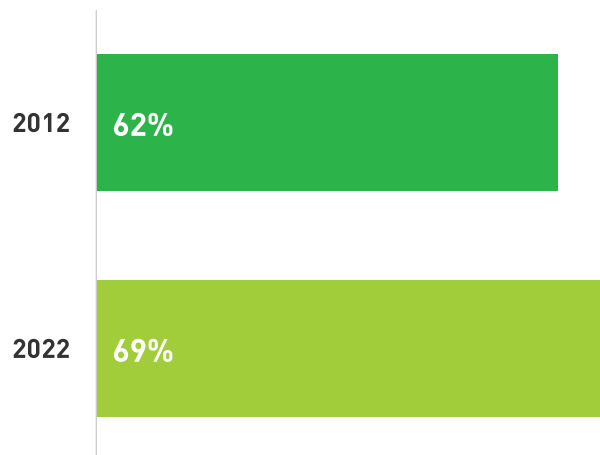

BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

Missouri WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by **10 percent** between 2012 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in Missouri in 2022, **21 percent** continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
