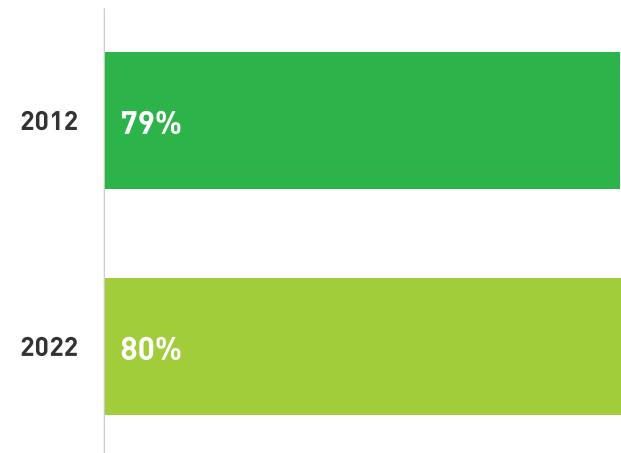

## BREASTFEEDING IN WIC

New York WIC breastfeeding initiation rates increased by **1 percent** between 2012 and 2022.



Among WIC infants who initiated breastfeeding in New York in 2022, **31 percent** continued breastfeeding at 6 months.
